Protocol for resuming EWF Events during COVID-19 Pandemic

Medical and Sanitary Clearance Procedures

Please note that the sanitary and medical clearance procedures may change in accordance with COVID-19 updates and the local government protocols.

Introduction:

Due to COVID-19 the landscape for sports has changed and all Federations will need to adapt to this changing environment.

The fundamental principle of the EWF throughout competitions during the COVID-19 pandemic is to protect and be protected by wearing masks, sanitising, distancing, and respecting the recommendations and protocols set by the Local Government, the Host Federation and the IWF.

National Health Regulations are paramount, and this document has been established to support the measures defined in the respective nations in order to provide guidance for implementing consistent standards and procedures in all countries hosting EWF events.

Should an individual test positive for Covid-19, the individual needs in first instance to follow the national rules that apply. (in most cases this is immediate isolation for a specified period of time; in some cases this also includes follow up testing after a specified time etc).

The EWF has no authority to interfere with national government applied quarantine rules (also when it comes to “contact persons”).

All persons should have the mutual responsibility to protect one another at all EWF competitions and events. Each person must use common sense in their behaviour, they must respect the instructions related to the COVID-19 pandemic, in particular barrier gestures and social distancing.

Officials and Teams may have to operate in “Team Pods” – “Group Bubbles”.

The event venues, the Hotel, Transport, Training and Competition Hall will be considered Bubbles. The objective is to reduce the COVID risk travelling between bubbles. People should not leave their bubbles as contamination could occur.

Transportation will be organised by the host Federation. Only persons with official competition accreditation will be allowed enter transportation vehicles. Host federation rules and regulations are to be strictly adhered to.

Hotels COVID-19 rules and regulations are to be strictly adhered to. Where possible hotels should be closed to the public. If this is not possible delegates and teams should be housed on separate floors to the public. Separate entrance / exit, elevators, dining rooms and socialising areas.

Competition and Training Hall. Before opening of the training and competition halls the Host Federation COVID-19 Manager must verify that the implementation of all COVID and health measures are complete. In between group sessions the Competition Area must be vacated to allow for deep cleaning using disinfectants by a professional company, areas to include corridors and Rest Rooms, Weigh- In Room, Warm Up Room, Competition Field of Play, Time is also to be allocated during training to vacate the areas for room air change and deep cleaning as required by local government guidelines. Host federation rules and regulations are to be strictly adhered to.

Event Objectives:

- The Russian Weightlifting Federation with the Moscow Department of Sports will host the European Weightlifting Championships
- The objective of the local organizing committee with the Moscow City Authority is to develop protocols for COVID-19 mandatory sanitary and medical rules and regulations.
- All participating delegations / teams, officials, staff, Volunteers, and media agree to follow these rules and regulations.
- Failure to follow these procedures may result in the removal of the accreditation issued for the event.

- *Please note that the sanitary and medical clearance procedures may change in accordance with COVID-19 updates and the Russian local government protocols.*

These Guidelines aim to achieve the following objectives:

Help ensure that an EWF event can be planned and executed in line with relevant best practice and in accordance with local government national public health guidance and regulations.

- Provide relevant health guidance for all stakeholders of an EWF event.
- Provide a framework for the detection, isolation, and management of a positive COVID19 infected person or persons during the sport event.
- Identify and share best practice for event management in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic, ensuring collaboration and exchange with all the sport stakeholders as well as other sporting authorities.

Deliverables

- The deliverables arising from these Guidelines include:
- A standardised COVID-19 risk assessment document for use by key stakeholders involved in EWF competitions.
- An expectation that each host National Federation develops and implements a documented plan for their role/function at each event.
- A review and where required modified rules and regulations applicable to the sport and risk environment.
- Create confidence and approval by the respective governments and regulatory authorities to support the resumption of Olympic Weightlifting competition within their jurisdiction.

WHO Competition Guidelines

WHO guidelines are characterised by the concentration of people at a specific location for a specific purpose over a set period of time and which has the potential to strain the planning and response resources of the country or community.

The definition is purposefully not linked to the size of the gathering or the number of people (although this obviously has an impact on the assessment of associated risks) because each community has a different capacity to manage crowds in practical terms, for regulation and guidance, national authorities may place a numerical limit for the definition of a group or mass gathering.

Quarantine This is the restriction of activities or the separation of a person or persons who are not ill but who may have been exposed to an infected person or disease. The purpose of quarantine is to monitor the symptoms of the potentially infected person or persons, whilst preventing further close contacts associated with potentially infected person or persons until such time as a diagnosis can be made.

Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) is protective clothing, masks, gloves or other garments or equipment designed to protect the wearer's body from injury or infection. The hazards addressed by protective equipment include physical, electrical, heat, chemicals, biohazards, and airborne particulate matter. It also includes respiratory protective equipment (RPE), such as face masks or respirators.

Terminology

Infected Person. An infected person is a person who has a positive PCR (laboratory) test confirming the presence of COVID-19.

Potentially Infected Person. A potentially infected person is someone who presents symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 following a close contact with an infected person but is not confirmed as an infected person due to lack of testing result.

Social Distancing. Social distancing, also called physical distancing, is a set of interventions or measures taken to prevent the spread of a contagious disease by maintaining a physical distance between people and reducing the number of times people come into close contact with each other. As described above, the precise definition of social distancing can vary between territories.

Close Contact. A close contact can be defined as: specific distance 0 + meters for a time period of >15 minutes. Provided direct care to an infected person without using proper personal protective equipment. Stayed in the same close environment as an infected person (including sharing a workplace, classroom or household or being at the same gathering) for any amount of time. Travelled in close proximity with (that is, within 1 metre separation) from an infected person in any kind of conveyance.

Isolation. This is the separation of ill or infected persons from others to prevent the spread of infection or contamination.

Key Principles

- a) To provide guidelines that act as a reference point for relevant information and facilitate a consistent, workable approach for the competition event in a COVID-19 operating environment.

To develop health & safety guidance to assist the relevant stakeholders in the development of the event plan that includes:
 - (i) a suite of fit-for-purpose risk mitigation measures to apply across the event.
 - (ii) the transmission mitigation measures, testing or monitoring of participants before during after an event, and their interactions with regulatory and administrative bodies.
- b) To provide a framework that is adaptable to the various levels of competition events to meet Government Guidelines and IWF Regulations that are in force in various jurisdictions which must be adhered to and respected.
- c) To develop a monitoring and tracing medium whereby possible close contacts can be readily identified in a timely manner.

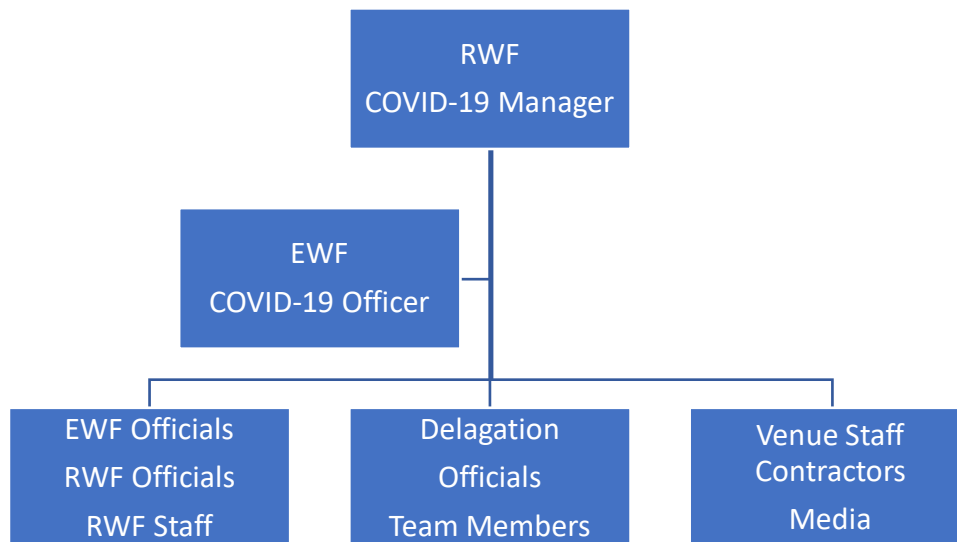

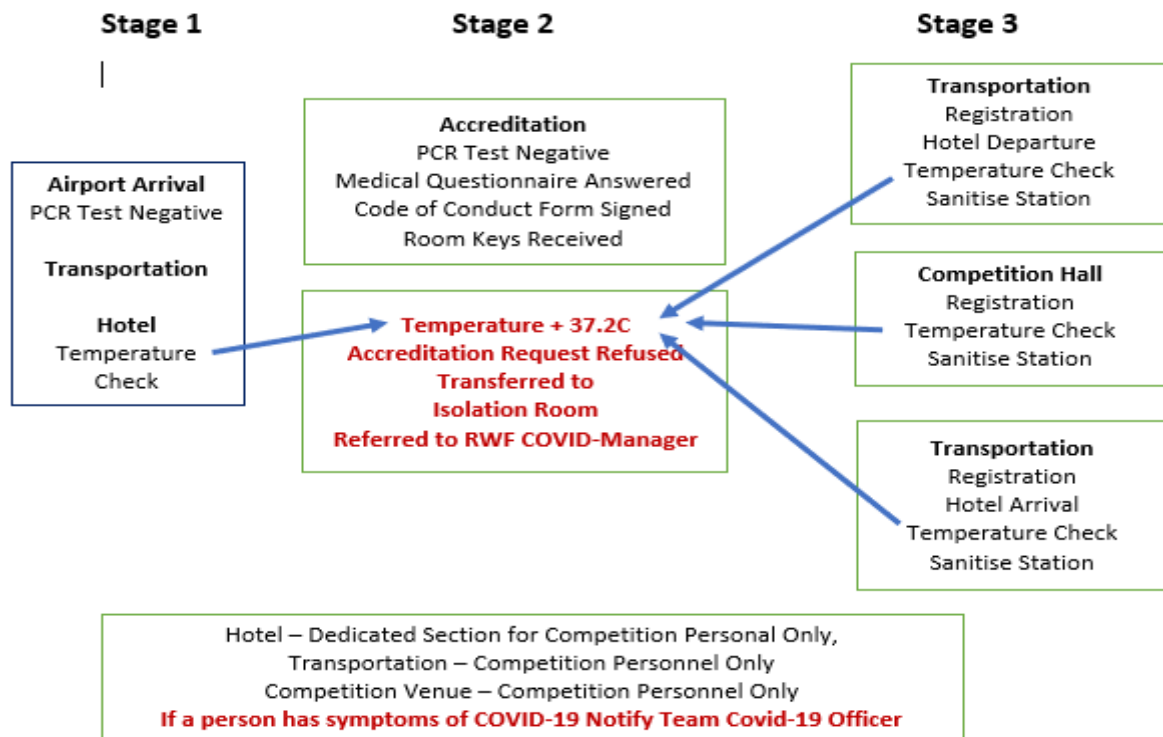

Delegation Check List

Delegation Before Travel

- Federation COVID-19 Liaison Officer / Team Leader.
- Federation required to ensure all representatives are insured to travel to competition.
- Take a COVID-19 PCR test within 72 hours of flight arrival in Moscow.
In English or Russian. Or official language of the country issuing authority with a Russian translation notarised by a Consular Officer of the Russian Federation.
- Prepare a list of the people you expect to have close contact with during your stay.
- Complete and sign 14 Day self-declaration document by all team.
- Signed the Code of Conduct document by all team.
- Complete Russia Cross Border Questionnaire.
- All relevant documentation confirmed, including Passport and Visa if required.

Please Note:

It is the responsibility of the Member Federation COVID-19 Officer to collect and store the original copies of the medical questionnaires and consent forms filled in and signed by the individuals registered for the event.

Make sure that each individual travelling to Moscow carries the hard copy of his/her negative RT-PCR test as it may have to be presented upon arrival to the local authorities and the organizers.

All costs related to the performance of this stage remain the responsibility of the respective Member Federation.

Arrival at Host Country

- Complete the medical questionnaire on the plane / airport on arrival.
- Give consent to the release of medical information.
- Wear relevant Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) Masks
- Present immigration authorities with your invitation, Visa and evidence of your negative COVID-19 Test and other relevant documents if required.
- Body Temperature will be taken.
- Mandatory COVID testing of participants will not be carried out upon arrival in Moscow. This testing can only be performed if COVID is suspected.
- Move quickly through the airport when you arrive and keep your activities to a minimum.
- Keep a look out for the Host Federation Officials and meeting point.

Please Note.

The information above is necessary to comply with the Order of Moskomspor No. 291 of October 02, 2020 "On Approval of Requirements aimed at preventing the spread of a new coronavirus infection." COVID-19 PCR test to detect SARS CoV2 genetic material (RT-PCR) in a nasopharyngeal or oropharyngeal swab. The result must be negative.

Transport to Hotel

- Stay with your Team Leader.
- Wait for Event Official to meet you at Airport.
- Separate transport for Federation teams or same flight passengers
- Each team member must manage their own luggage inside and outside the vehicle.
- Temperature will be taken before entering bus.
- Sanitise your hands before entering the bus.
- Wear your mask.
- Obey rules when arrive at destination.

Transportation

Specific arrangements will be in place to ensure that buses do not run with full capacity, allowing for social distancing. Passengers will be required to sanitise their hands before entering the buses while masks must be always worn. The buses will be disaffected between each journey.

Please Note:

- In all airports and railway stations of the city of Moscow, strict compliance with measures to protect against COVID-19, compliance with the glove-mask regime, compliance with the social distance of 1.5 meters is required.
- All employees of the meet-and-see groups and drivers who meet and see off participants and guests of the event observe the glove-and-mask mode and a social distance of 1.5 meters.
- The meeting at the airport is made by RWF Staff in the arrival's hall with a sign promoting the championship logo.
- An employee of the meeting-send-off group accompanies the arriving participants and guests to the vehicle. The waiting time for transport is no more than 30 minutes.
- Transport services are provided by buses, minibuses, and passenger cars. Passenger seating in all modes of transport, with the exception of passenger cars, is staggered.
- All vehicles are equipped with sanitizers. Masks and gloves are not provided to passengers.
- Traffic is carried out according to strictly regulated routes (airport-hotel-stadium). After each trip, the driver disinfects the interior of the vehicle.
- All measures to protect against COVID-19 are mandatory for all categories of transport, both fixed and operating on the shuttle system.
- The hotel and the stadium will be equipped with traffic control points. Traffic controllers observe the glove-mask mode and the social distance of 1.5 meters.

Individuals and Teams arriving directly to the Official Hotels with their own means of transportation, should inform the LOC about the expected arrival date and time. They must present the RT-PCR result at the information and accreditation desk, after which they will be issued a voucher for check-in.

Hotel Arrival and Stay

All hotels should be solely used by the participating teams and officials. If this is not possible there will be segregated areas with social protection barriers in place and separate entrance / Exit for competition personnel. Hotel will organise specific floors for team and officials' bedrooms. The hotel staff will operate in line with hotel sanitary procedures and a risk mitigation plan will be in place which has been developed in accordance with Russian legislation.

- Hotel COVID-19 and Host Federation rules and regulations are strictly enforced.
- Single rooms recommended. Double room is maximum size.
- Hotel arrival – Temperature testing at hotel entrance
- Wait in designated area.
- Team Leader and Covid-19 Officer will go to Accreditation room.
- Room Keys and all event documentation will be issued to the Team Leader.
- No room changes will be permitted.
- Stay within your group "Bubble" when in Hotel, transport and training.
- Do not use Hotel sauna / leisure / pool facilities.
- Food in restaurant should be at specific times for buffet.
- Hotel weigh scales to be available with cleaning and sanitising equipment available.

Please Note:

- In case of detection of elevated body temperature (Subfibrile 37.1;37.2), a number of the following actions will be performed.
- The information is transmitted to the COVID-19 Officer and the chief competition doctor.
- The participant is escorted to the isolation room.
- An ambulance is called.
- If COVID-19 PCR Test is required, the federation team must pay fee

Accreditation

- A maximum of two persons per delegation allowed in accreditation room.
- Temperature test may be taken before entry.
- Ensure 1.5-meter distance.
- Disinfect any or all materials after each delegation.
- Final Competition documentation will be required.
- 14 Day self-declaration document for all delegation members will be required.
- Signed Code of Conduct document for all delegation members will be required.
- Produce a copy of Federation Delegation Insurance.
- Confirm flight details for the departure COVID-19 PCR test.

Please Note:

It is the responsibility of the Member Federation COVID-19 Officer to collect and store the original copies of the medical questionnaires and consent forms filled in and signed by the individuals registered for the event.

Hotel

All meals will be served in the hotel restaurants where a one-way-traffic system will be in place. Wearing a mask is mandatory at all times in the restaurant except only if you are seated and eating at your designated table. If you walk away from your table, you must wear your mask. Entering and exiting the Restaurant you must clean your hands with sanitising gel. Please do not spend more than 45 minutes in the Restaurant.

Please Note: Meals

Accreditation must be presented to be admitted in the restaurant. Wearing a mask is mandatory at all time in the restaurant, except while eating and drinking. Everyone entering the restaurant must clean hands with sanitising gel.

Service will be provided according to National/Regional/Local Government regulations in force at the time, as well as hotel internal rules regarding sanitary restrictions. The dining room layout will ensure physical distancing of at least 1.5 metres. To facilitate the process, restaurants' service hours will be extended. Shifts will be organized to respect social distancing and room capacity limitations.

Transportation to Training and Competition

- Host Federation Transportation rules and regulations are strictly enforced.
- Wait in designated area.
- Temperature Testing may take place.
- Stay in team waiting area. Orderly entry System to bus.
- Arrival at Venue – Stay within the Team “Bubble”
- Allow extra time due to temperature testing and sanitising.
- Departure – Stay in designated waiting area with team,
- Arrival at Hotel. Allow for Temperature and Sanitise

Training

- No Spectators – Accreditation persons only.
- Host Federation Training Hall rules and regulations are strictly enforced.
- Deep Cleaning to take place before and between groups.
- Arrival – Temperature and sanitisation area
- Arrive in Training outfit
- Platforms spaced two metres apart.
- IWF guidelines for equipment apply.
- No sharing of equipment with other platforms
- Only use team Chalk / Water / Platform number
- Depart to bus waiting area after training.

Competition Venue

The Training and Competition facility areas will be solely used by the participating teams, officials, media, and contractors. No external spectators will be allowed in these areas. The venue staff will operate in line with Russian sport facilities sanitary procedures and a risk mitigation. An event plan will be in place which has been developed in accordance with Russian legislation.

Please Note:

1. At the entrance to the sports facility of competitors, judges, as well as officials, body temperature control is carried out by the Moscow Authority of Sport in a non-contact way.
2. Participants, judges and officials with normal temperature are allowed to enter the competition.
3. In case of detection of elevated body temperature (Subfibrile 37.1;37.2) the information is transmitted to the chief physician of the competition. The participant is escorted to the isolation room. The participant takes the COVID-19 test. In case of a positive result, the participant is admitted to a local hospital. In case of a negative result, the participant is re-measured the temperature. If the temperature is normal, he continues to participate in the competition. If the temperature is elevated, the ambulance assigned to the event takes the participant to the hotel and the participant is removed from the competition.
 - If you need treatment for an injury or illness - COVID-19, you must specify these forms of treatment in the international insurance pole.
4. Athletes and team delegation, Officials are required to have insurance in case of injuries and COVID. The insurance is presented at the information and accreditation center in the hotel.
6. Medical assistance at competitions is provided by ambulance teams, information is brought to the chief doctor of the event-Zotkin Vladimir Nikolaevich Tel. +7-985-761-70-51.

Prior to Departure

- Participants who need to take the RT-PCR test to return to their country of residence at least 3 days before departure. Participants must fill out an application stating their departure details at the accreditation center in the hotel stating that they want to take the test. The test fee is 40 euros. Testing will take place in a specially designated room at the event venue.
 - Further information about the conduct of such additional tests will be provided during the accreditation procedure.
- All costs related to the performance of these additional tests remain the responsibility of the respective Member Federation.

Doping Controls

Doping controls will take place at the main venue Irina Viner-Usmanova Gymnastics Palace. Athletes will be required to wear their accreditation badge to facilitate the identification process, in case they are selected for doping control. The doping control station will be designed to ensure social distancing during all phases of doping control operations. All antidoping staff, athletes and accompanying persons will be required to wear mask (and where applicable gloves) for the entire procedure. Doping control operations will be conducted in strict accordance with AIU COVID-19 special instructions to Doping Control Personnel.

Media and Broadcasting

A specific Medical Clearance Protocol for Media will be published before the opening of the event's Online Press Accreditation System.

Press Conference

Only accredited media with negative COVID PCR test results will be allowed in the press conference room. The press conference room must accommodate seated media, respecting social distancing. Photographers and TV personnel should have a limited possibility to move to get the coverage needed. The head table for the speakers must be 2.5-3 m away from the 1st row of seats. On the head table no extra microphones will be allowed except the one from the main audio system.

Broadcasting

Broadcasting staff should comply with the health protection procedures outlined in this document. Broadcasting staff is required to limit contact with athletes, team officials, other media to a strict minimum. Should interaction with the above-mentioned groups occur, broadcasting staff should follow a minimum social distancing of 1.5 meters. The broadcasting compound should be supervised by dedicated security personnel provided by the LOC and have dedicated toilets and washroom. Wearing mask is mandatory at all times.

Media Centre and Tribune

As the Media center is usually indoor, it is recommended that media staff keep their mask the whole time. Everyone entering the Media center should clean their hands with hand sanitizer. LOC should make sure that proper disinfection of the area is done before the opening. LOC should secure an intermediate cleaning every 3 hours in the Media center. Distance of 2 meters between each table/chair.

Please Note:

Measurement of the body temperature will be conducted before boarding the airport/train station shuttle service (upon arrival): entering the competition venue (Irina Viner-Usmanova Gymnastics Palace) or the training venue in case of high temperature specific measures and additional medical checks will be applied.

Defined secured flows at the event venues must be strictly followed.

Everyone must comply with travel regulations in force at the time of the journey and must have enough masks and hand sanitizers for the entire journey duration. Under standard condition a surgical mask should be changed every 4 to 5 hours to keep its protective effect optimal.

The purchase of personal protective equipment is under the responsibility of the Member Federation, or the athlete or the representative.

General Measures

Daily Check

- Any intentional interaction with a person not accredited or not directly involved in the organisation of the Event is strictly forbidden at all times.
- Wearing a mask covering the mouth and nose is obligatory at all times, except: when seated at a table to have a meal (one must wear a mask if she/he leaves the table for any reason, even for a short period of time).
- Masks must be worn by all in the Warmup room except athletes on warm up platform and competing.
- Wash/sanitise your hands regularly.
- No handshakes – greet each other with a bow.
- Wear a face mask (change at least twice a day)
- Wear gloves if required and dispose after use.
- Maintain social distancing where possible 1.5 – 2 meters.
- Disinfect your mobile phone.
- Use your own pen, do not give it to someone else.
- Have you own chalk at training and warm up room.
- Be the only one to use the same paper documents, mobile phone, bottle of water, etc.
- Athletes have chalk for training and competition.
- If a person has symptoms of COVID-19 notify your Team Covid-19 Officer or a COVID-19 Manager immediately

Personal Hygiene Measures

- Take a shower with soap.
- Air your bedroom by opening windows regularly.
- Wash and sanitise your hands.
- Wear a fresh mask.
- Change mask regularly.
- Sanitise pens, plastic materials, etc.
- Note the location of the nearest restroom and hand washing facility.

During the day

- Wash and sanitise your hands regularly.
- Change you mask at least 2 times a day.
- If wearing gloves replace regularly.
- Sanitise your equipment regularly.
- Sanitise your hand before putting on a fresh mask.

At the end of the day

- Wash and sanitise your hands.
- Sanitise your personal equipment.
- Collect all litter / garbage and put in bin.

COVID-19 PROTOCOL AGREEMENT FOR TEAM DELEGATIONS

The Russian Weightlifting Federation will host the European Weightlifting Championships

The Russian Weightlifting Federation will organise the event to the highest safety measurements in line with Russian Government event and sport protocols. The local organizing committee with the Moscow City Authority has introduced protocols for COVID-19 mandatory sanitary and medical rules and regulations.

- **All participating delegations, officials agree to follow these rules and regulations. Failure to follow these procedures will result in the removal of the accreditation issued for Event.**
- ***Please note that the sanitary and medical clearance procedures may change in accordance with COVID-19 updates and the Russian local government protocols.***

All official members of Team Delegations, whether they are competitors or staff, international or local are obligated to:

- Present, on arrival, an individual COVID-19 medical certificates (PCR test made within 72 hours before arrival) with a negative result.
- The certificate must be in English or bilingual with English as one of the languages.
- Present prior to receiving accreditation an individual Declaration of Absence of COVID-19 Symptoms for at least 14 days prior to Event arrival day (to be provided separately)
- Always wear a mask during the Event, with exceptions of:
- Athletes on the training, warm up and competition platform, where it is the choice of athlete's participants in respective hotel rooms, where it is the choice of participants during their meals only when seated at their dining table.
- Always carry Event accreditation.
- Always observe social distancing (1.5 m) wherever and whenever possible.
- Avoid entering hotel rooms of other participants under any circumstances.
- Avoid any contact with individuals who are not accredited at the Event.
- Submit to contactless temperature screening by the LOC and/or local health authorities at any time during the Event period.
- Submit to PCR and/or other COVID-19 testing at any time during the Event period on request of the COVID-19 Managers and/or local health authorities.
- Follow all instructions of LOC or COVID-19 Event Managers, including following isolation, quarantine, observation procedures and provision of detailed contact tracing in case of need.
- Timely report all COVID-19 protocol violations during the Event COVID-19 Manager

In addition to the individual obligations, participating National Federations must:

- Appoint a COVID-19 contact person from the official Team Delegation list, who will be present during the Event and will oversee any COVID-19 related issues for their Team Delegation.
- Ensure the delegation of all Team Delegation members do not have serious underlying health conditions known to increase the risk of lethal outcomes from COVID-19.
- Ensure that the registration procedures are timely and completely followed (last minute changes to the number of participants, rooming lists etc. will not be allowed).
- There will be no mandatory quarantine periods for Team Delegations in the Tournament host country provided there is no positive COVID-19 test result. In case of amendments to the protocol the LOC will inform all participants in timely manner.

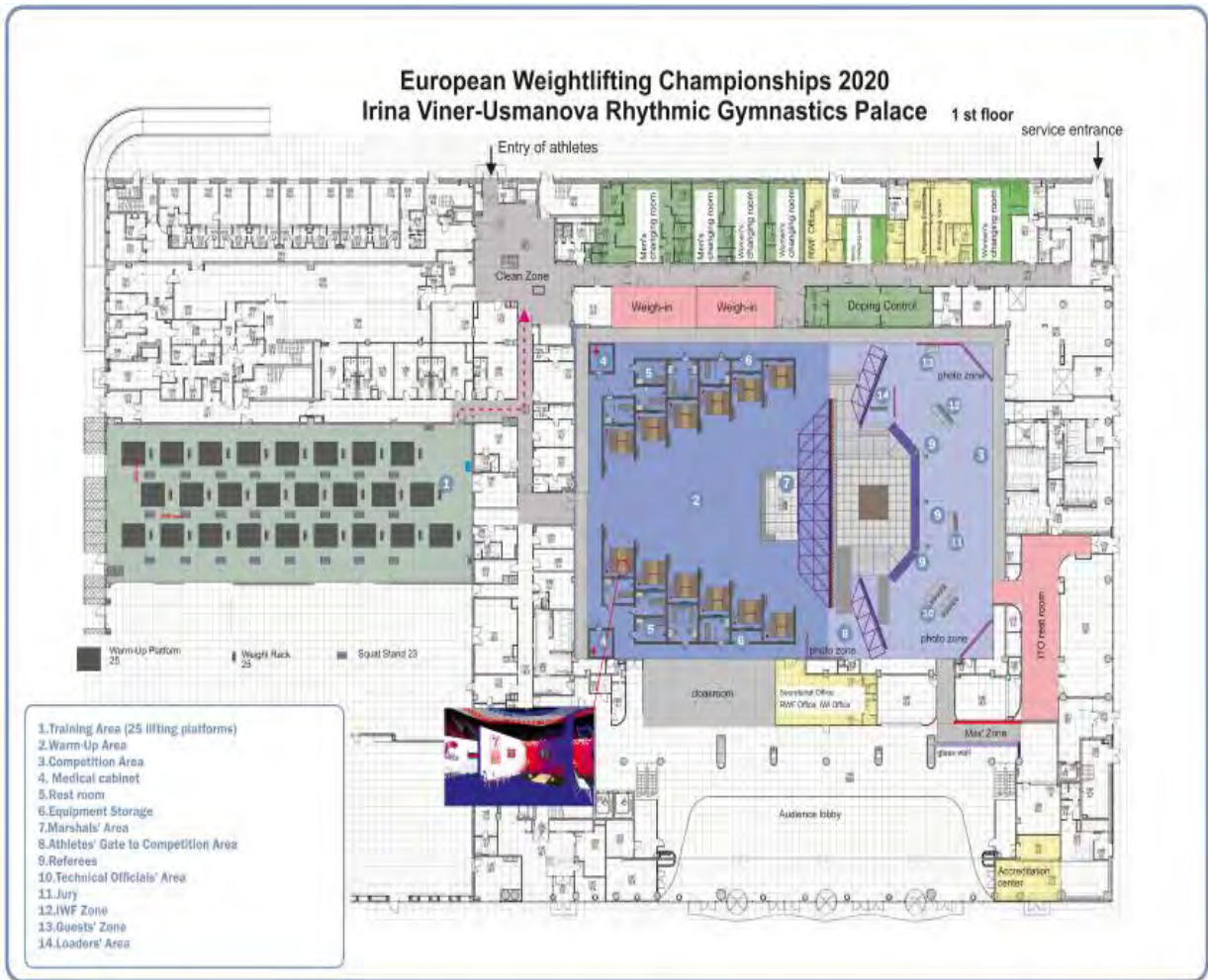

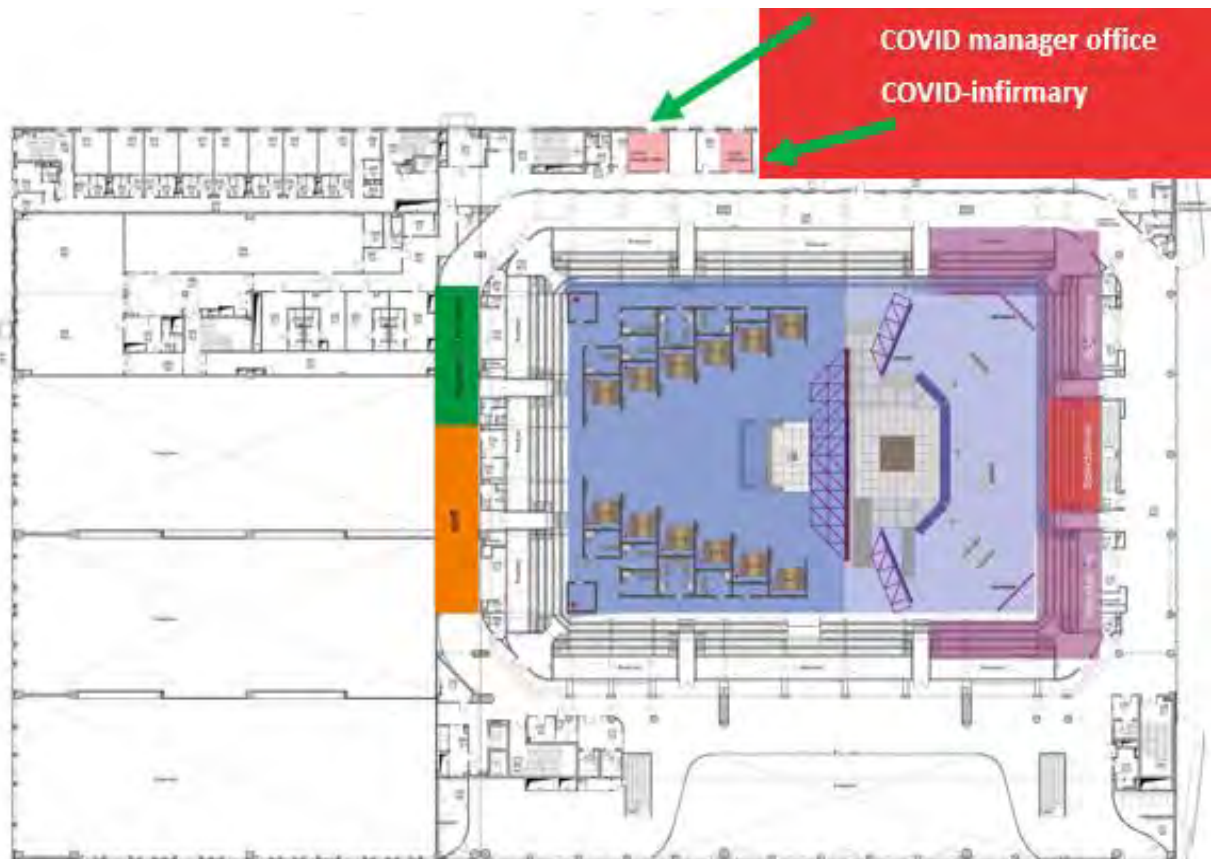
